Appalachian Chamber Music Festival Announces New Partnership for 2023 Season

Harpers Ferry, W.Va. – The Appalachian Chamber Music Festival is excited to announce a new partnership for their 2023 season. ACMF will come together with the National Park Service’s Harpers Ferry National Historical Park to produce an outdoor concert event on Sunday, August 27 from 3 to 5 pm on the grounds of the former Storer College in Harpers Ferry, West Virginia.

This concert will be free and open to the public, and will feature a special performance by old-time fiddler Earl White and the Earl White String Band, guest speaker Nancy Cook who will speak on the importance of Harpers Ferry as a “Place That Inspires”, and a chamber music performance with ACMF musicians.
