Appalachian Chamber Music Festival Presents English Folk Band Howay The Lasses
ACMF presents Howay The Lasses in Concert

Harpers Ferry, W.Va. – The Appalachian Chamber Music Festival has announced a limited engagement tour featuring English folk band Howay The Lasses July 20 - 23.

‘Howay The Lasses’ are a vibrant new collaborative that celebrate the lives of notable women heroes of the North East of England through original songs and arrangements. Singer and accordionist Annie Ball, father and daughter singer-songwriter combination Gareth and Bronwen Davies-Jones, and cellist Katie Tertell began working together in 2021. The result is an engaging and original canon of material in tribute to the lives of historical characters such as engineer Rachel Parsons and mathematician Janet Taylor as well as contemporary figures like artist Sheila Graber and even the Newcastle United Women’s Football team.

Concerts include both free and ticketed events, as well as some outdoor venue options. Concerts will feature original works from their self titled album released in 2022.

Howay the Lasses’ free concerts include Friday, July 21 at 2 pm at Charles Town Public Library; Friday, July 21 at 5 pm at The Gazebo at Harpers Ferry Public Square; and Sunday, July 23 at 3 pm at Brambleton Library.

The tour will conclude with a ticketed event at The Barns of Harpers Ferry on Sunday, July 23 at 7 pm. Tickets are available through the venue, \$10 advance or \$15 at the door. Visit The Barns of Harpers Ferry on Facebook for additional information.
